Attached is an invoice from our committee, for your annual subscription as a business member of ECBaT for 2020/21. For those who are already members, we appreciate your support, and ask that you continue to do so.

Our committee receives no other funding. We apply for grants for each major individual project. Your small contribution is very much needed to enable our work to continue for smaller projects & contribute to bigger projects. Without our committee its unlikely many town improvements would ever happen.

The most positive thing to happen in our district in the last few years has been the building of our Caravan Park & development of the Lavender Federation Walking Trail. The Eudunda Caravan Park was built & organised by our committee has been well utilised in the past several years and we are just now finalising the extension of our powered sites. The Lavender Trail would not be in our town or district without the input, encouragement & support of our committee. Indeed, members of our committee helped build the trail through our district & are still actively involved in long term trail maintenance. We are seeing both walkers & caravaners spending money in our shops, buying meals & staying at our pubs, visiting the heritage gallery etc. This is all helping to make our town & shops more viable & therefore still here when you need them. Calculations have been made which would indicate the Caravan Park Tourism has put at least \$50000 per year into the local economy.

We have been successful in obtaining a grant of \$60,000 to have the silos painted and a short list of artists will display their concepts in Eudunda soon for locals to vote on which they would like to see on the silo. In conjunction with the grant for the silos we were also successful in obtaining a grant of \$80,000 for landscaping of the silo area which will also incorporate a carpark.

We have been overseeing the implantation of the \$50800 grant we received from Dept Recreation & Sport and Goyder Council for the Swimming Pool Upgrade. We now have a pool blanket & motorized roller, a 6m X 8m shade structure, internal pool safety fencing and new easy access steps in & out of the pool.

New Projects we wish to see in updated Goyder Master Plan 2019

- ongoing discussions with council regarding the housing subdivision development at the end of Michael St.
- upgrading visitor centre in main street
- negotiate "ownership" of the Railway Station & a secure lease arrangement on the rest of the Viterra land that will enable us to use the land for our purposes.
- Develop the railway line to Hampden for use by bikes & strollers.
- Develop a town newsletter from what is currently available online.
- A Dog Park in Eudunda
- The cemetery needs a shelter shed, rainwater tank & a directory & perhaps even a toilet.

There are many, many smaller & larger projects that need doing in our community if we have sufficient volunteers & funds.

We would like all businesses that are members of ECBaT to provide us with input as to what things you think we should be doing to further assist business in our community.

If you would like to hear about the things that ECBaT are currently doing, I invite you to our monthly meetings which are held on the first Monday of each month, at the Saints Club rooms, Bruce Street at 7.30 pm.
